LOCAL AUTHOR GEORGE SLAUGHTER PUBLISHES E-BOOK OFFERING QUICK TIPS ON IMPROVING YOUR TECHNICAL WRITING

KATY, TX—March 4, 2016—Like many writers, George Slaughter has a collection of articles that he prepared and published over the years. Many of those articles address technical writing topics, and he has compiled them into his first e-book.

“Quick Tips for Improving Your Technical Writing: Adding Value Through Effective Communications” is exclusively on Amazon Kindle. It sells for 99 cents for a limited time.

“Over the years I’d write articles that would address various technical communication-related topics,” Slaughter said. “For example, what are the four value questions that your writing must answer? How do you prepare for a technical writing assignment? How can you work better with subject matter experts?”

While “Quick Tips for Improving Your Technical Writing” is Slaughter’s first e-book, he is also a traditionally published author. In November 2011, Arcadia Publishing released Slaughter’s book *Spring Branch*, a pictorial history of the west Houston neighborhood. To create that book, Slaughter interviewed descendants of original settlers and culled historic, previously unpublished photographs from private collections.

Slaughter began his own freelance writing practice, Onion Creek Productions, as a continuation of his 30 years in professional writing, 25 of which were spent in technical writing. He produces business-related content for clients, including articles, brochures, news releases, newsletters, technical documentation and web site content. He is also a contributing writer for CoveringKaty.com.

Slaughter is a senior member of the Society of Technical Communication (STC), the world’s largest and oldest professional association dedicated to the advancement of the field of technical communication. He is a two-term past president of the Houston chapter and a recipient of its Distinguished Chapter Service Award.

Slaughter is also a member of Business Networking International (BNI), the largest business networking organization in the world. He is active in the Cinco Ranch chapter.
